DANNY PAYNE, Operations Manager, HOGAN PROPERTIES, 621 North Robinson, \$100, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, telephone (405) 278-6013, advised that his firm owns the Journal Records Building at 6th and Hudson Streets, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. His boss, DAN HOGAN, owner, HOGAN PROPERTIES, instructed him to obtain the videotape which was made on April 19, 1995 from four cameras stationed on the outside of the Journal Records Building. One camera photographs the south side of the building, which includes an outside stairway. HOGAN thought that the camera on that side of the building may have obtained some type of photograph of the persons responsible for the bombing of the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building on that date. PAYNE noted that the video camera in question was blown off the wall, so there is likely no video after the time of the blast.

PAYNE noted that since there was no electricity in the building, he was giving the interviewing Agent the entire video player along with the videotape, since he could not get the videotape out of the player. He advised he would like to have the video player back at some point. Thereafter, PAYNE provided a Koyo video player with serial #512105, and a videotape enclosed in it.

SA HIPPARD turned this video player over to SA KEVIN L. LEGLEITER on the same date.
