STATEMENT BY FBI SPECIAL AGENT IN CHARGE WELDON L. KENNEDY

Investigators have identified a vehicle that was used in connection with yesterday's attack on the Federal Building in Oklahoma City. Further investigation has determined that two white males were associated with that vehicle.

As a result, arrest warrants will be sought for these two males. Their exact identities are not presently known. Thus, the arrest warrants will be for two men, each identified as "John Doe."

The first man is medium build. He is further described as about 5'10"-5'11" tall, weighing about 180-185 pounds, with a light brown crewcut, and he is right-handed.

The second man is also medium build. He is further described as 5'9"-5'10" tall, weighing about 175-180 pounds, with brown hair, and a tattoo visible on his left arm below his teeshirt sleeve. He is possibly a smoker.

Composite sketches of these two men have been prepared. We have copies here for everyone.

Both of these men should be considered armed and extremely dangerous. Citizens should not, therefore, attempt to take any action against them.

Anyone with information about these two men should provide it immediately to the nearest FBI office. They can also call phone banks we have specially established to receive their information. We urge people with information to call 1-(800) 905-1514. That number will be effective starting at 5:00 P.M. Eastern Daylight Time.

This information has been communicated to law enforcement at all levels -- domestic and international.
