identities of the interviewing Agents and the nature of the
interview, that being PATTERSON's observation of a Ryder truck in
Mulhall on the morning of April 19, 1995. PATTERSON thereafter
provided the following information:

PATTERSON is a loan processor/secretary at the Oklahoma
State Bank, located on Highway 77 in Mulhall, Oklahoma.
PATTERSON arrived at the bank at approximately 7:55 a.m., and
noticed a Ryder truck parked on the street (Highway 77), facing
south, in front of the old bank building which is just across the
street from the Farmer's Store. Behind the Ryder truck was
parked the truck of a local man named JOHN LOUGH, who is a
routine morning customer of the Farmer's Store. PATTERSON
described the truck as medium-sized, and was not new looking (it
had faded letters). PATTERSON noticed the truck because it
looked out of place. PATTERSON did not see the truck leave.
PATTERSON could provide no further information regarding this
matter.
