MARY I. HUNNICUTT, a White female, date of birth [REDACTED] home address [REDACTED] telephone number [REDACTED] was contacted at [REDACTED] the home of NANCY FILLMORE. HUNNICUTT was advised of the official identities of the interviewing Agents and the nature of the interview, that being HUNNICUTT's observation of a Ryder truck in Mulhall on the morning of April 19, 1995. HUNNICUTT thereafter provided the following information:

HUNNICUTT is the postmaster in Mulhall, and at approximately 6:00 a.m. observed a Ryder truck parked on Highway 77, facing south, directly in front of the old bank building. The FARMER'S store is located directly across the street from the old bank building. HUNNICUTT noticed the Ryder truck because she stopped at the FARMER'S store on her way to work to purchase a soda from the machine located outside the store. HUNNICUTT also noticed a light colored car, which HUNNICUTT described as a "big old honkin' car" and was "scruffy looking," which was parked next to the Ryder truck. HUNNICUTT could only see the front portion of the car because it was parked on the opposite side of the Ryder truck, and was slightly forward of the truck. Both vehicles were facing south. HUNNICUTT thought that the front grille of the car had some damage near the driver's side headlight. HUNNICUTT could not recognize the color of the car because at 6:00 a.m. it is still fairly dark.

HUNNICUTT did, however, take a good look at the truck and vehicle because she was concerned about getting out of her car to buy a soda in the presence of two strange vehicles.

HUNNICUTT described the Ryder truck as medium sized. Other people in town who may have observed the truck are HERMAN FLASCH, telephone number [REDACTED] and HAROLD RICHARDS, telephone number [REDACTED] HUNNICUTT could provide no further information regarding this matter.
