The following investigation was conducted by Sergeant ROBERT STORY, JUNCTION CITY, KANSAS POLICE DEPARTMENT and Special Agent (SA) RONALD J. KOZIOL at Junction City, Kansas, on April 23, 1995 regarding an interview of FERNANDO RAMOS reference the investigation into the bombing of the ALFRED P. MURRAH Federal Building on 4/19/95 in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.

RAMOS, described as a Hispanic male, date of birth May 29, 1951, 514 W. Spruce, Junction City, Kansas, 913-238-7315, employed at ELLIOTT'S AUTO BODY SHOP, was interviewed at the JUNCTION CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT regarding a blue Jeep Cherokee.

RAMOS was interviewed in Spanish by SA JOSE JIMENEZ and RAMOS advised that during the week of April 17, 1995 he observed an individual at the Ryder rental shop of ELLIOTT'S AUTO BODY SHOP that was similiar in appearance to the composite drawings shown on TV of UNSUB #1. UNSUB #1 was later identified as TIMOTHY MCVEIGH, who had rented a truck at ELLIOTT'S AUTO BODY SHOP on 4/17/95 which ultimately was used in the bombing of the federal building in Oklahoma City on 4/19/95.

RAMOS advised that he observed two individuals at the shop in a blue Cherokee Jeep. RAMOS described the passenger as a male white, 5'9", 200 pounds, 30-35 years of age, blonde hair, blue eyes, blue t-shirt, blue jeans, and gym shoes. RAMOS did not see the driver of this vehicle. RAMOS stated he prepped the RYDER truck for this individual and attached a tow-dolly to it. RAMOS stated that this individual was similiar to appearance of UNSUB #1.

A review of ELLIOTT'S RYDER records revealed no tow-dollies rented on Monday 4/17/95. The only dollies rented were on Wednesday, 4/19/95.
