

## FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION

Date of transcription 4/24/95

MARTIN JOHNSON, Date of Birth 2/20/74, was contacted at his place of employment, the Oklahoma City County building, 7401 NE 23rd, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. JOHNSON was previously interviewed on 4/22/95 and 4/23/95. JOHNSON provided the following additional information:

JOHNSON advised that on 4/13/95, he arrived at the Federal building at approximately 4:50 PM. On the first floor of the Federal building, JOHNSON witnessed a man standing by the mail area rummaging through some mail. JOHNSON stated that the man appeared to be in his 30's, was approximately six feet tall wearing his hair in a crew-cut. JOHNSON stated that the man was wearing light blue mail man type shorts, light blue button down pants and black lace-up shoes. JOHNSON stated that the man appeared to be a mail man, although he did not have any keys on his person and there was no mail truck parked outside the Federal building.

JOHNSON advised that on 4/17/95, between 5:30 and 6:30 PM, he again saw the crew-cut man on the first floor of the Federal building by the mail area. The man appeared to be wearing the same light blue clothing and black shoes as seen on 4/13/95. The crew-cut man was observed talking to another man that JOHNSON described as being an "Indian". JOHNSON stated that the "Indian" was approximately three inches shorter than the crew-cut man, stocky build, black hair, dark complexion. The man was wearing a white short sleeve shirt and "dickey" type pants which were baggy. JOHNSON is not sure of the color of the pants but stated that the man had something blue in color hanging out of his right rear pocket. JOHNSON believes the Indian male to be in his 30's.

On 4/18/95, JOHNSON again observed the crew-cut man by the mail area wearing the same clothing as on the previous two occasions. At approximately 4:50 PM, while on the 9th floor, JOHNSON observed the Indian male enter the men's restroom. JOHNSON was removing his cleaning equipment from the supply room adjacent to the restroom. The supply room door was open and blocking the restroom door. The Indian male pulled the supply

room door out of the way and, in doing so, caused it to bump into JOHNSON. He then turned to the Indian male and said "What's up?". The Indian male did not respond and proceeded into the restroom. JOHNSON cannot recall what type of clothing the Indian male was wearing at the time.

JOHNSON advised that approximately one month earlier, he had seen the same Indian male at the Old Post Office building, near the area known as the Tech room. The Indian male was

five foot long. JOHNSON further advised that the Indian male could have been a contract construction worker.

JOHNSON was shown a composite drawing of UNSUB #2 and indicated that this was the same individual he saw in the Federal building with the crew-cut man, as well as in the Old Post Office building. JOHNSON stated that the Indian male did not appear as "mean" as the face in the composite drawing. JOHNSON signed the back of the composite drawing that was shown to him by interviewing agents.

JOHNSON described the mail area of the Federal building as being on the right side of the main hall inside of the front entrance. JOHNSON drew a sketch of this area which was labeled by SA BEHREND. The location of the crew-cut man is indicated by a circle with an "x".

JOHNSON stated that the crew-cut man seen in the Federal building was the same individual he observed in a line-up conducted on 4/23/95. This is same individual which was in position two in the line-up. JOHNSON restated that the reason he did not identify the individual at the line-up was because he was scared that the individual could see him through the glass.
