## Report: Diary reveals plans for bombings; Phoenix included

FORT WORTH, Texas (AP) — A newspaper reported today that federal authorities have found a diary in which Timothy McVeigh and associates outline plans for simultaneous bombings in Oklahoma City, Phoenix, and Omaha, Neb.

The diary says the group didn't have time to acquire enough explosives for all three cities and decided to concentrate on the Oklahoma City federal building, the Fort Worth Star-Telegram reported, quoting two unidentified high-ranking federal officials.

But Justice Department spokesman Carl Stern and Weldon Kennedy, special agent in charge of the FBI in Oklahoma, said they had no information about a diary.

As for the reports of other planned

bombings, Stern said, "Of course, we've received reports that McVeigh planned other attacks. We take them all seriously" and check each out. Stern specifically mentioned the published accounts of someone looking like McVeigh casing a federal building in Omaha.

One source told the paper that the diary "also suggests that the individuals had cased the places and were aware of all the tenants in those

buildings at all three locations."

That would indicate the culprits knew there was a day care center in the federal building. At least 14 of the dozens of victims were children.

The newspaper didn't specify who kept the diary, how many people were involved in the plot or what deadline the bombers were trying to make.

However, the bomb went off exactly two years after the deadly government raid that ended the standoff at the Branch Davidian compound in Waco, Texas. Authorities say McVeigh, the only person arrested so far in the bombing, held extreme anti-government views.

The sources said they didn't know when or where the diary was found or whether it mentions anyone other than McVeigh by name.
