ERIC MCGOWN, date of birth April 14, 1978, Desk Clerk, DREAMLAND MOTEL, 520 East Flint Hills Boulevard, telephone number (913) 238-1108, was advised of the official identity of the interviewing agent and that he was being interviewed concerning the bombing of the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, which occurred on April 19, 1995. He was advised that he was specifically being interviewed concerning the time he recalls seeing a yellow Ryder truck associated with TIM McVEIGH, a guest in room 25 at the DREAMLAND MOTEL, during the time period of April 14, 1995 through April 18, 1995, first arrive at the DREAMLAND MOTEL. Thereafter, he furnished the following information:

He saw a yellow Ryder truck being driven by TIM McVEIGH, the man who was a guest at that time in room 25 at the DREAMLAND MOTEL, arrive at the DREAMLAND MOTEL at about 4:00 p.m. on Sunday afternoon, April 16, 1995. He saw this Ryder truck when he returned from eating at a restaurant in Manhattan, Kansas, with his family on Easter Sunday.

He also associates seeing the Ryder truck with an afternoon that he was cleaning the swimming pool at the DREAMLAND MOTEL. He cleaned the swimming pool on both Sunday, April 16, 1995, and on Monday, April 17, 1995.
