SUMMARY: Billy Joe Pierce, nee: Stanley, a former girlfriend of SColburn describes her relationship with him and what she knew about him. Pierce's boyfriend, Ken Stofflet, claimed to have seen TMcVeigh at the Colorado Bell in 02/00/95.

ATTORNEY ANALYSIS: @ RJW. Billy Joe Pierce, nee: Stanley, a former girlfriend of SColburn describes her relationship with him and what she knew about him. Pierce's boyfriend, Ken Stofflet, claimed to have seen TMcVeigh at the Colorado Bell in 02/00/95. Pierce provided interesting insight into SColburn's life. SColburn had several caves where he would store survival materials in the Oatman, Arizona area.

Pierce described SColburn's relationship with "Bob" LNU and the fact that SColburn had told her that Bob makes machine guns and that Bob had some of SColburn's guns. SColburn further advised that Bob was in a group that helped people with problems. FBI 302 Serial No. D-5435, Bates 013118-26, details an interview with Karen Anderson. Karen stated that she knows several people named Bob, including one that runs Bob's Gun Shop in Hot Springs, AR and a Bob Warren that runs a place called "The Farm" where one can rent machine guns and fire them on his property. Perhaps at SColburn was referring to one of these individuals or BMiller himself.

Interestingly, Ken Stofflet recalled seeing TMcVeigh at the Colorado Bell which is a restaurant in Laughlin, Nevada. Mr. Stofflet recalled seeing TMcVeigh in 02/00/95. Immediately after stating this information, the interview was terminated. When the interview was resumed four hours later, Mr. Stofflet was not part of the conversation.
