

The following investigation was conducted by Special Agent (SA) JERRY L. WAGNER at Florence, Arizona:

On May 17, 1995, ROY L. BOYD, Inmate Number 110923, ARIZONA STATE PRISON (ASP), was reinterviewed in response to a second letter he had written to the FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION (FBI). In the letter, BOYD said he had not told the FBI everything he knew when interviewed on May 5, 1995.

BOYD said that in his telephone conversation with LOUIS BEAM in June or July, 1994, BEAM told him that the primary target of a bombing in retaliation for Waco, Texas would be the Oklahoma City Federal Building because that is where BOB RICKS of ALCOHOL, TOBACCO AND FIREARMS (ATF) was located. Secondary targets were the Denver Federal Building because an unrecalled FBI official at Waco was from Denver, and the third target was the Dallas Federal Building because some judge there had made a ruling favorable to gay rights.

BOYD said BEAM never named names of participants or specific dates of the possible bombings, but BEAM just said things were "lined up".

BOYD said he was in Michigan in 1988 and met a ROBERT MILES. MILES is a former KLU KLUX KLAN (KKK) member and he started his own militia type organization. BOYD said he stayed about a month and learned how to make bombs out of fuel oil, fertilizer and batteries. He said they set off some small bombs in the woods.

BOYD believed MILES, JOHN BAUMGARDNER of Orlando, Florida and RICHARD BUTLER of Hayden Lake, Idaho must be involved in OKBOMB because of their past activities. BAUMGARDNER is Imperial Wizard of the KKK and author of the "Invisible Empire". BUTLER is with the ARYAN NATIONS. BOYD had no specifics of their involvement.

Again BOYD said he does not know TIM MC VEIGH, TERRY NICHOLS, or others named so far in OKBOMB. BOYD has never been to Kingman, Arizona.
