

## Man Accused of Blowing Up House in Arizona is Arrested

KINGMAN, Ariz. - A man accused of causing a blast that rocked a home in this northwest Arizona city in February has been arrested, police said.

**Clark Vollmer**, 44, was arrested Friday after being discharged from Kingman Regional Medical Center for skin ulcers.

Mr. Vollmer was booked into the Mohave County Jail on a charge of arson of an occupied structure, said Tonya Dowe, spokeswoman for the Mohave County Sheriff's Department.

Mr. Vollmer and **Dennis Malzac** are believed to be responsible for a Feb. 21 explosion that blew five windows out of a home near Kingman. Mr. Malzac was arrested in April and remains in the county jail.

Federal authorities had investigated the explosion as a possible trial run for the Oklahoma City bombing because suspect Timothy McVeigh is known to have ties in Kingman.

Mohave County authorities have denied any connection between the two events.
