JANE CLEARY GRAHAM, employed at the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, residing at the U.S. Department of Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73120, telephone detected date of birth social security account number was contacted regarding her observations preceding (April 16 through April 19, 1995) during, and after the bombing of the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building on April 19, 1995. She provided the following information:

On the morning of April 19, 1995, GRAHAM arrived at work at approximately 8:00am after her husband dropped her off in front of the 5th Street side of the building. GRAHAM did not notice anything or anyone unusual on her way to work and recalled that there were not any cars parked in the circle in front of the building. She did not recall seeing a yellow Mercury Marquis, a blue pick-up with a white camper shell, or a Ryder truck.

GRAHAM was at work on April 17 and 18. She did not see anyone or anything unusual on those days, nor did she see anything out of the ordinary when she passed the YMCA on her way home each day.

Some time during the week before the bombing, probably on Wednesday, April 12, 1995, she observed a situation which she thought was unusual. On that day she parked in Federal Building parking garage, on the north side of Level B. From her parking slot in the garage located three spaces east of the double doors inside the garage, she noticed three men standing at the west end of the garage looking st some sort of plans. All of them looked like workmen because they were dressed in work clothes which consisted of blue jeans, and with at least one of them wearing a tool belt. She knew that the men were not General Services Administration (GSA) employees because those workmen normally wore uniforms. Adjacent to where the men, all white males, were

standing was a vehicle which she described as an older model station wagon, faded light green or gray, full of some sort of equipment. The men apparently had arrived in that vehicle because she saw one of them reach into the vehicle for something. GRAHAM could recall no further details but simply recalled that seeing the men there seemed odd.

Some time during that same week, GRAHAM recalled seeing an unknown man in the elevator of the Federal Building. The man, hereafter referred to as Unknown White Male (UKWM) asked about where the Office of Personnel Management (OPM) was located. She explained to him that most of the hiring done by OPM is centralized now, and, therefore, they are located in Washington, D.C. GRAHAM recalled that the man seemed upset by the fact that OPM did not have an office in the building. UKWM is described as follows:
