

## FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION

Date of transcription 1/9/1996

SHAWN ANTHONY KENNY, male white, Date of Birth, June 7, 1958, was reinterviewed regarding his knowledge of RICHARD LEE GUTHRIE, JR., and PETER KEVIN LANGAN.

KENNY previously stated that he had gone on numerous "dry runs" with GUTHRIE and on some with both GUTHRIE and LANGAN.

KENNY was taken to the vicinity of the Tri-County Mall and the SOCIETY BANK located at 11355 Princeton Pike, Springdale, Cincinnati, Ohio. KENNY was not shown the location of the SOCIETY BANK, but driven through the streets bordering the bank. At one point KENNY noticed a strip of stores running behind the SOCIETY BANK, and parallel to Princeton Pike, that contained a GENTRY's men's clothing shop and then stated that this was the area of one of the "dry runs." KENNY then stated that it was in fact the SOCIETY BANK, 11355 Princeton Pike, that both he and GUTHRIE and LANGAN had gone on "dry runs" in the past.

KENNY during the earlier "dry runs" at this bank had been assigned to drive the get-away vehicle and was parked at the end of the strip of stores very near the GENTRY's. The intention of GUTHRIE and LANGAN were to run from the bank and behind the strip of stores to the waiting vehicle parked by the GENTRY store. They would then precede out onto Princeton Pike and past the bank to make their escape.

Another bank recalled by KENNY was one in the EASTGATE MALL area on the east side of Cincinnati. KENNY stated that he is not familiar with the east side of Cincinnati and was taken to the vicinity of the EASTGATE MALL. KENNY did not initially identify a particular bank but recognized the back entrance (west side) of the mall itself. He commented that the new KOHL's department store was not there when he had gone there with GUTHRIE but that GUTHRIE seemed to be familiar with the Eastgate area.

The plan at that time was for KENNY to park near the west side mall entrance and await GUTHRIE. GUTHRIE would rob the bank on the east side of the mall, run across the parking lot and

into the mall's east side entrance. He would then walk through the mall, exit the west side and meet KENNY and the get-away vehicle. They would then drive back around the mall, passing the bank and making their escape. The use of a bomb device as a diversion was always part of the initial planning and with this particular robbery GUTHRIE had discussed using a bicycle for the initial escape through the parking lot.

KENNY then observed the banks located on the east side of the EASTGATE MALL and identified the PNC (formerly Central Trust Bank), 4579 Eastgate Boulevard as the intended target. KENNY could not be certain if either GUTHRIE and/or LANGAN had subsequently robbed this bank.

KENNY recalled that when he last saw GUTHRIE, around November, 1994, he was driving a late model smaller style station wagon, red in color, with paneling trim on the sides, bearing Ohio license plates. This vehicle had been stored for a time at PARKIE SCOTT's residence off Interstate 74, north of Cincinnati, around November, 1993.

KENNY was also aware that GUTHRIE had a late model, Chevrolet, Sonoma pick up truck, blue in color with a camper top, that KENNY believed he had purchased from a dealer, on time, and never paid for. GUTHRIE gave this vehicle to a friend of his who owns a farm in Arkansas.
