MICKEY WAYNE LESCH, date of birth [REDACTED] security account number [REDACTED] Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, home phone number 405/840-0564, was contacted to determine a date on which the interviewing agent could conduct a face to face interview. LESCH was advised of the identity of the interviewing agent and the purpose of the interview. LESCH advised the agent that his work schedule would not allow for such a meeting. LESCH then provided the following information:

LESCH is a foreman for OKLAHOMA ROOFING AND SHEETMETAL, 1705 South Lowrey, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, telephone 405/670-1429. On April 19, 1995 at approximately 2:30 AM, LESCH and a crew of approximately six men were roofing the Federal Courthouse. It was at this time that LESCH and at least two other crew members noticed a white Ford Bronco circling the Murrah Federal Building. The reason it caught their attention was that it appeared to resemble the infamous O.J. Simpson Bronco. The Bronco circled the building approximately two to three times at a extremely slow rate of speed, estimated at 15 miles/hour. At the end of the last loop, the Bronco stopped at the southwest corner and seemed to park on the side walk. The vehicles lights lit up the south side of the building for a short period and then the vehicle left at the same slow rate of speed.

Due to his vantage point, LESCH could not provide any information concerning the occupant(s) of the Bronco.

LESCH identified two other crew members who also observed this activity. These crew members were BOYD LARABEE, who, according to LESCH, no longer works for the company, and KEVIN WELLS.
