BRUCE LUBECK, Assistant United States Attorney, Salt Lake City, Utah, advised after reviewing existing records concerning the prosecution of the Salt Lake City investigation "Operation Punchout", he did not locate any letter of declination generated by his office regarding ROGER MOORE. LUBECK did locate a docketing sheet in which LUBECK documented that on August 21, 1991, he declined prosecution of ROGER MOORE pursuant to the FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION's request for a prosecutive opinion which cited insufficient evidence in the matter involving ROGER MOORE. LUBECK provided to the investigator a copy of the docketing sheet.
