

## FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION

[REDACTED] was contacted at [REDACTED] residence located at [REDACTED] was advised of the identity of the interviewing Agent, as well as the nature of the interview, and thereafter provided the following information:

[REDACTED] was met at [REDACTED] residence where [REDACTED] resides with [REDACTED] requested that [REDACTED] identity be protected due to the fact that [REDACTED] believed individuals associated with Andreas Strausmyer would cause [REDACTED] bodily injury if they found out that [REDACTED] was talking to the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI).

[REDACTED] claims that [REDACTED] was born in [REDACTED] and raised in a cult-like atmosphere to a religious sect known as [REDACTED] [REDACTED] indicated that this group is similar to the Mormons, but have a Pentecostal viewpoint of religion. [REDACTED] noted that they all attended the same school and that they were a close knit group of families but were non-militant.

As [REDACTED] was growing up, during the summers senior elders of the [REDACTED] would send out flyers to other religious groups around the country and meet at various locations around the country to argue the Bible. When [REDACTED] was approximately [REDACTED] years of age [REDACTED] and the [REDACTED] met in an unknown location in Oklahoma meeting with individuals of Elohim City, specifically Bob Millar and Andreas Strausmyer. [REDACTED] became very interested in this group and when [REDACTED] was approximately [REDACTED] years of age [REDACTED] left the [REDACTED] area and went to reside at Elohim in Oklahoma. [REDACTED] believes that was approximately [REDACTED] months and [REDACTED] ago. [REDACTED] resided there approximately [REDACTED] months and met many of the occupants who resided at this militant encampment. During that time frame, [REDACTED] remembers people coming in whom [REDACTED] believes were from the Michigan Militia and from another militia in Montana. [REDACTED] cannot recall any specific names or addresses of these individuals.

Investigation on 5/16/96 at [REDACTED]File # 174A-SA-56120, [REDACTED]Date dictated 5/22/96

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[REDACTED] became infatuated with the residence of Elohim and began doing military training exercises at the Elohim City location which took place on a daily basis. [REDACTED] recalls that the individuals who also participated had firearms and some explosives. These explosive devices consisted of what [REDACTED] believed to be homemade hand grenades and that those hand grenades were received from a person named Vernon who resided in Waco. [REDACTED] now believes that this individual was David Koresh and that Strausmyer had picked up those hand grenades from Mount Carmel. According to [REDACTED] there is a large barn on the property and that barn contains firearms and crates of shells and ammunition. It also contains food items such as granola.

According to [REDACTED] Elohim City is owned and run by Bob Millar who is approximately sixty years of age. [REDACTED] has a large family consisting of four sons, the oldest whom [REDACTED] could not recall the name of, the second oldest was named John, forty years of age, the third oldest named Fred, thirty-five years of age, and David, who was twenty-six years of age. [REDACTED] noted that all the males who reside at Elohim City do not have monogamous relationships with just one wife, and some have numerous wives and children of unknown lineage. The family maintains financial stability through the ownership of a trucking company which is owned by the oldest son of Millar. According to [REDACTED] Millar's son owns approximately seven Peterbilt trucks and hauls items across the country. On many occasions, [REDACTED] has seen items being loaded on the trucks at Elohim City, but [REDACTED] did not know the specific natures of the items which were being sent. It was [REDACTED] opinion that those items were not legal and they were normally put on the truck with other shipments of legitimate items.

On many occasions, [REDACTED] heard Millar talking that his group was going to "start the fight that starts the war". He claims that he was going to try to instigate a fight with the FBI and that this would be initiated at Oklahoma City. While [REDACTED] was residing in Elohim City, [REDACTED] stayed with [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] is married to [REDACTED] who is described as a white female, blonde hair, blue eyes, twenty-one years of age [REDACTED]

When questioned regarding Pete LNU and [REDACTED] association with Timothy McVeigh, [REDACTED] indicated that Pete LNU was a white male, approximately thirty years of age, 6'1" to 6'2" in height, 280 pounds, having dark curly hair and was extremely muscular. [REDACTED] noted that Pete's appearance was that of a very chiseled look

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and he normally wore some type of a military hat. It was [REDACTED] impression that Pete was born somewhere in Africa and had migrated to the United States several years prior to him living at Elohim City. On one occasion, [REDACTED] recalls acts of violence being committed against an individual who had lived at Elohim City. This individual, name unknown, was being evicted from the location due to the fact that they believed he might be a homosexual. As this individual was getting into his motor vehicle to leave, Strausmyer, Millar, and several other adult males began shooting at his vehicle as he attempted to drive away out of Elohim City. [REDACTED] did not believe that this individual was shot or injured.

Pete LNU often spoke regarding his displeasure with the United States Government and it was [REDACTED] personal opinion that Pete may be involved in the bombing of the Oklahoma City federal building. [REDACTED] felt this was the case because Pete was an extremely large individual and he would be the type of person with the type of disposition that would assist Timothy McVeigh in loading large drums of explosives on to a Ryder truck. [REDACTED] also had the opportunity to look at the photograph of Unsub #2 displayed on or about the time of the Oklahoma City bombing. [REDACTED] believed that this artist's conception looked very similar to that individual known to him as Pete LNU. [REDACTED] had no specific knowledge of Pete LNU involved in any criminal activities regarding the bombing of the Oklahoma City Federal Building, nor did he reside at the location when that incident occurred. [REDACTED] was questioned regarding any specific threats [REDACTED] heard anyone make regarding the overthrow of the United States Government or bombing events in the United States, and [REDACTED] indicated that Bob Millar had said on occasion to a group of people that "we are going to have to blow this place up". [REDACTED] did not specifically say what location they were talking about, but noted that he was normally referencing Oklahoma City.

When questioned regarding the relationship between Timothy McVeigh, Strausmyer, and Pete LNU, [REDACTED] indicated that both Strausmyer and Pete LNU met an individual named Timothy at a gun show in Oklahoma City. [REDACTED] recalled Strausmyer claiming that Timothy, or Tim, could get anything that they needed and [REDACTED] took that to mean weapons and explosives. Thereafter, [REDACTED] recalls Strausmyer mentioning Tim's name on a frequent basis.

After residing at Elohim City for approximately [REDACTED] [REDACTED] left the location due to the fact that training exercises were getting exhaustive. According to [REDACTED] they would have to do many military drills throughout the day and stand guard at night in shifts. [REDACTED] never specifically told

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Millar or Strausmyer that [REDACTED] was going to leave Elohim City [REDACTED]

When questioned regarding any other criminal activity that Strausmyer or Millar were involved in, [REDACTED] could not think of any specific incident other than the time when Strausmyer claimed that he went to Houston to kidnap the daughter of an individual who was of Phillipine decent. [REDACTED] claimed that this Phillipine girl was being held against her will by a black male. [REDACTED] claimed that Strausmyer told [REDACTED] that he confronted a black male with a firearm, at which time he shot the black male with some type of a sawed-off shotgun. [REDACTED] does not know this to be true, but felt that Strausmyer was capable of doing such an act due to the fact that [REDACTED] saw Strausmyer fire at the homosexual individual in the past, shooting up his automobile. It was [REDACTED] opinion that Strausmyer, Millar, and others who reside at the compound would be involved in actual violence against the government.

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
