CHARMAYNE FARLEY, 2 [REDACTED] East Viddle, [REDACTED] was interviewed at her place of employment, LADY GODIVA'S, 1850 South Sheridan, Tulsa, Oklahoma, telephone 918/836-8536. After being advised of the identities of the interviewing Agents and the nature of the interview, FARLEY provided the following information:

FARLEY advised that she has been a dancer at LADY GODIVA'S for the past four years, usually working at night, and she goes by the stage name of "SYDNEY."

FARLEY particularly remembered a night in April 1995 due to the fact that two other dancers at LADY GODIVA'S got into a fight in the dressing room.

That same night, another dancer going by the stage name of "TERRA" came to FARLEY and informed her that she had just met a man in the bar who seemed to have a lot of money, and that he was about to become famous and come into some more money. There were two other individuals with this man, so FARLEY went with TERRA to their table to see if they would purchase them drinks. The man TERRA spoke about wore a suit and tie and was a "really good looking" young man with dark features. FARLEY could not recall what the other two men who were sitting at the table looked like. The man TERRA was with did spend a lot of money at the club that night.

A few days ago, FLOYD RATCLIFF, the owner of LADY GODIVA'S, asked FARLEY to look at three pictures he had. FARLEY recognized the first two pictures to be that of Oklahoma City bombing suspects TIMOTHY MCVEIGH and TERRY NICHOLS, as she has seen their pictures numerous times in the newspaper and on television. She informed RATCLIFF that she had never seen either of them in LADY GODIVA'S, and that she did not think they were the two individuals sitting with TERRA's man that night in April 1995.

FARLEY identified the third picture, which had the name "MICHAEL" written on it, to be the man sitting with TERRA that night in April 1995. She specifically recalled this individual

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due to his "good looks," and the fact that he seemed to have so much money.

FARLEY stated that NBC NEWS did come to LADY GODIVA'S, but she was not working at that time and thus did not speak with them.
