PAMELA JEAN NEOUK, white female, date of birth [REDACTED] Social Security Account Number [REDACTED] was interviewed. NEOUK is currently staying with her sister in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma; however, does not know the street address. She provided a telephone number of [REDACTED] NEOUK was advised of the interviewing Agents' identities and the purpose of the interview.

NEOUK advised that she is currently employed at [REDACTED], where she works as a waitress. NEOUK advised that prior to her employment at [REDACTED], she had danced as a topless dancer on and off for approximately four years. Specifically, NEOUK remembers that on April 8, 1995, she was dancing at LADY GODIVA'S, 1850 South Sheridan, Tulsa, and believes that she went to work at approximately 8:00 p.m. that evening. NEOUK remembers working near the "second stage" located in the southeast corner of LADY GODIVA'S. She remembered as she was working "several people" at a table. NEOUK primarily associated with one male at the table who she described as a white male, 6' tall, full beard (short and bushy), dark brown hair, 35 - 40 years of age, who she described as "quiet." The individual was dressed in a flannel shirt and dark blue jeans or dark pants. NEOUK stated she sat with this individual almost the whole night until she later fainted/passed out in the women's dressing room.

NEOUK remembers a second white male seated at the table who she did not really associate with that evening. She described him as a white male, "tall," 6'1", thin build, no facial hair, short light colored hair, approximately 30 years of age. NEOUK could not provide a clothing description on this individual. NEOUK remembers the man as being "spooky," and stated that she had never seen this individual in the club before. NEOUK remembers being at the table when the second unknown male began talking to her and made the comment, "You're going to find a love that's gonna break your heart," and numerous other comments.

NEOUK was shown a video recording of comments she made on April 8, 1995, in the women's dressing room at LADY GODIVA'S. NEOUK remembers the comments being made; however, she did not

know why the individual made the comments, nor did she have any indication what he may have meant by the statements.

NEOUK stated the comments were unsolicited and not related to any conversation she was having with the second unknown male.

Later, at a funeral for a friend, NEOUK was approached by FLOYD RATCLIFF, owner of LADY GODIVA'S. RATCLIFF told NEOUK that "BRUCE" from NATIONAL BROADCASTING COMPANY (NBC) NEWS needed to talk to her. NEOUK later talked to BRUCE (last name unknown) (LNU) on the phone regarding the events and persons at the club on April 8, 1995. Later, NEOUK met BRUCE at RATCLIFF's residence in Tulsa. At the residence were NEOUK, her ex-husband, DAVID HILL, RATCLIFF, and a crew from NBC NEWS. NEOUK stated that the questions were based on the events of what occurred at the club on April 8, 1995. NEOUK was shown pictures of TIM MCVEIGH, but she did not recognize MCVEIGH as being at the club on April 8, 1995. NEOUK distinctly remembers being shown a "whole bunch" of photographs and being asked if she recognized each individual in the photographs. In addition, NEOUK was asked if it was "possible" that the persons depicted in the photographs were at the club. NEOUK remembers telling NBC NEWS that "anything is possible." NEOUK, however, did not recall nor recognize any of the photographs that were displayed to her as persons being at the club on April 8, 1995.

NEOUK remembers that BRUCE (LNU) gave her a business card; however, the card had a name BOB SANDS, telephone [REDACTED], pen [REDACTED], and fax number of [REDACTED]. NEOUK did not know who BOB SANDS was or if in fact that was BRUCE's true name. In addition, NEOUK was given the business card of MIKE BOETTCHER, which was handwritten on the card above the imprinted name of MICHAEL MOSHER, with a handwritten number of 800/NBC-WEST, [REDACTED]. NEOUK provided the business cards to the interviewing Agents and they were copied and returned to NEOUK.

NEOUK recalls RATCLIFF gave her an article to read from "AMERICA ON-LINE" which depicted the events at the club on April 8, 1995. NEOUK remembered that she was "furious" in that

the article contained statements attributed to her that she did not make.

NEOUK reiterated that she did not identify any of the photographs presented to her by NBC NEWS, including photographs of TIM MCVEIGH and MICHAEL FORTIER.
