NARRATOR: DAVID SNIDER, A WAREHOUSE SUPERINTENDED WHO WORKED ABOUT 5 BLOCKS FROM THE MURRAH BUILDING, TOLD INVESTIGATORS MCVEIGH DEFINITELY WAS NOT ALONE THAT MORNING.



Snider: *"I was standing out here on this back dock waiting for two guys and a truck to come pick up some computer equipment that we had."*

"Between 8:35 and a quarter till 9 I see a Ryder truck come out of the East, headed to the West, they turned South onto Oklahoma towards me at a very slow rate of speed."

"When they got up close to me, which I could see both men, McVeigh was sitting on the passenger side and I'm waving at him, trying, you know, to get their attention, that I just knew that was the guys that were coming to pick up my stuff."

Interviewer: *"Why is it that you so remember seeing Timothy McVeigh the morning of the bomb blast?"*

Snider: *"Because he looked right at me with a scowl on his face, which I took personally, and you know, I made some comments towards him as he was driving by."*

Interviewer: *"What did you say?"*

Snider: *"You want the real truth? I told him 'fuck you, you skinhead looking motherfucker.'"*

NARRATOR: BUT THE MAN WITH MCVEIGH, ACCORDING TO SNIDER, DID NOT MATCH THE GOVERNMENT'S DESCRIPTION OF JOHN DOE #2.
