





The religious philosophy of the USANP and the Christian Posse Comitatus is that of "Christian Identity". This is the religious philosophy that links many of these groups to the Aryan Nations.

Skinheads, although aligned with Aryan Nations, practice the "Odist" (phonetic) religious philosophy.

The differences between the two philosophies are:

Christian Identity - members believe they're <u>messengers</u> of God.

Odists - members believe they're <u>soldiers</u>

of God.

Both of the religions, however, are associated with one another and they're chief goal is to overthrow the government of the United States.
